How will my application be assessed?



All the initial lettings and any future re-let's will be made in line with Wirral Councils 'Allocation Procedure for Extra Care Housing'.

To apply for extra care housing, you will have to request a social work assessment. The assessment will identify whether you have a need to access the 24-hour care and support that is provided on site. This care and support is to respond to emergency or unplanned care and support needs and is a chargeable service (see leaflet 'Extra Care Services')

Once a full assessment is completed your application will be considered by an Allocations Panel against the following eligibility criteria. You must:

- have a local connection with Wirral through residence, family or employment
- be aged 55 years or over
- have a combination of housing, support or care needs, which could include requiring assistance with daily living tasks or:
- be an older carer with a dependent who has a learning or physical disability

If you would like to live at Poppyfields and you feel that you meet the above criteria then please get in touch to set things in motion by completing an application form.
